

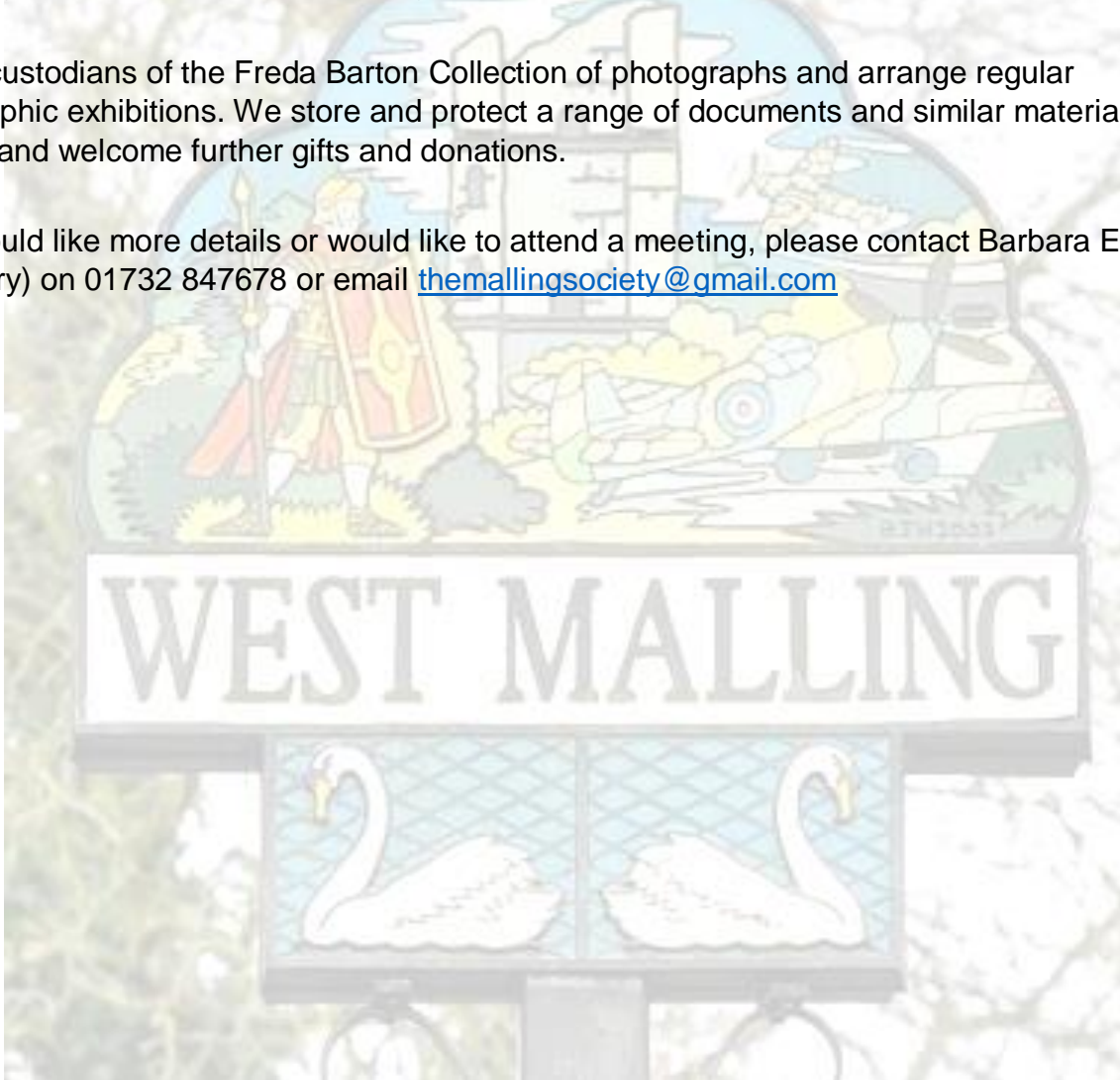
The Malling Society aims to:
